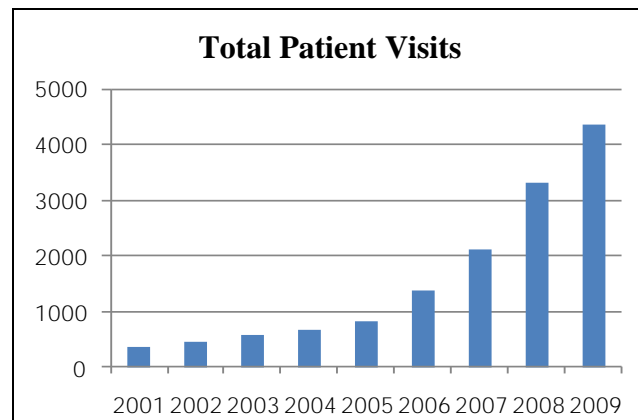
New Hope Clinic

New Hope Clinic in Brunswick County is completing a \$500,000 capital campaign to construct a new clinic, provide additional equipment and necessary operating funds. The new clinic is located in Boiling Spring Lakes next to the food pantry. We need your help to close our campaign successfully.

New Hope Clinic is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit public charity that provides free medical care for the low-income, uninsured residents of Brunswick County. Volunteers and a small staff funded by grants provide medical and dental services ensuring that quality healthcare is accessible in Brunswick County. Eighty percent of our patients are treated for chronic diseases with follow-up care. These follow-up services are not available at the county’s hospitals. Our services reduce the use of emergency rooms for routine or episodic care, saving the hospital and health care system the direct cost of uncompensated care.

New Hope Clinic’s services include:

From January 2009 – December 2009, New Hope Clinic provided a total of 4348 visits, a 31% increase over the previous year. Professionals provided a total of 12,228 service hours in 2009 with a value of \$276,985.

Why is the building needed?

When New Hope Clinic opened in 1998, it offered visits one evening a month in a school classroom. In late 1999, the clinic converted a rented office space in the Sentry Storage Business Park outside Southport to accommodate a once a week clinic. Services have expanded over the years and the clinic now operates five days and several evenings a week - out of that same 1,200 square foot office space.

The space constraint causes complications of efficiency, quality of service, and patient confidentiality.

Volunteer medical providers often do not have timely access to an exam room or space to conduct follow-up consultations or reports. There is also no space for lay volunteers to perform work at the clinic. They do not have access to telephones, computers, or desks, and there is no training or meeting space. This seriously effects the clinic's ability to provide consistent help for patient reception and interviews, record-keeping, fundraising, and special event needs.

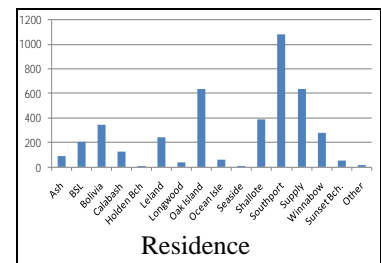
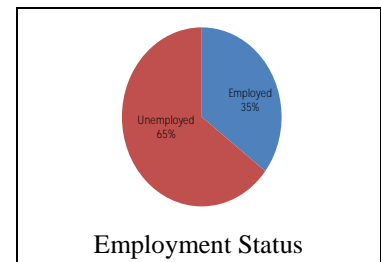
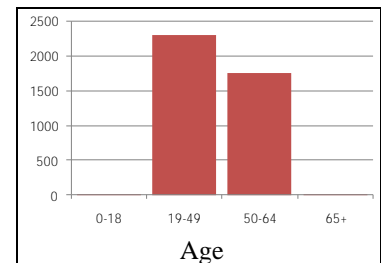
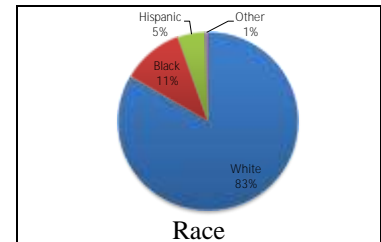
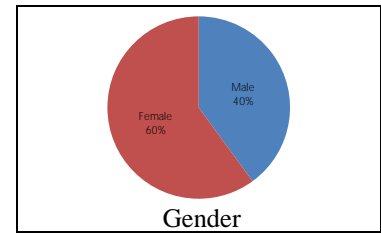
The new clinic building, scheduled to open in the summer of 2010, will more than triple our existing space, allowing the clinic to increase its patient capacity, improve privacy, and maximize the use of volunteer resources. It includes 4 exam rooms, 4 interview rooms, an expanded pharmacy, an additional dental room with lab and a nurse's station.

Our new waiting room will triple the space of our current waiting room and will include a children's play area sponsored by the Southport-Oak Island Kiwanis Club. In the future during off clinic hours, the waiting room has the potential to serve as an exercise space and possible orthopedic rehabilitation space. There is also a large multipurpose room for patient interviews, and meeting space for educational classes.

The new kitchen will give us the opportunity to have cooking classes for diabetic patients and families.

Additional space will be available for social services and to expand case management. According to the *County Health Rankings: Snapshot 2010-Brunswick*, 18% of residents in Brunswick County have inadequate social support.
